The first list begins with the Core Classes.

(They meet more than one day or are possibly a two-hour class, and camper is required to be there all the days or hours offered to complete the class)

The list following the Core Classes are Elective Classes.

They are one day classes and do not require other classes to be taken with them. You may also sign up for more than one day if you choose, but again no guarantee there will be room for the camper to take two of them.

The age group allowed to take a class is listed in parenthesis to the right of the class name.

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Archery - (5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>) 2-day class
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Oh Yeah! Shoot the arrows at the target and get the feel of a bow in your hands. This activity is carefully supervised by Grand Valley Sporting Goods. Day 1 will be learning how to shoot. Day 2 will be competition!





This is a two-hour class. Campers will be transported to "Zemaitis Lake" on Linden Dr. Learn fishing and cane pole skills off the bank. Bring your own rod and reel. Be sure to label your rod & reel with your name. Bait will be provided. Adult supervision at all times. Learn some fishing tricks from fishermen that have enjoyed this sport for years.

Jerky & Brats – (7th-8th) - 2-day class 1 hr. Mon. & 1 hr. Thurs.





Learn how to cure & smoke jerky, link & smoke sausage and make fresh bratwurst. Treats to take home on Thursday and brats to be fixed for the picnic Thursday evening.

Little Fairy House Construction - (all) – 2-day class



Just imagine what you can do with a little pixie dust and a few other objects. Make a little fairy house for little fairies who fly through the forest looking for a place to rest their wings. These are individual creations made from found objects such as moss, stones, sticks and pixie dust.

Mixed Media Cat/Dog Art (all) 2-day class

Use an array of materials to make a unique animal themed picture




Pony Class – $(2^{nd}-4th)$ - 2-day class



Basic horse care techniques/instructions & fun facts for those who don't have a horse at home. We will do basic ground work and we will ride!! Requirements: **CLOSED TOED SHOES**! On the second day of class, the students will need a helmet (a bike helmet works great!) because they will have an opportunity to ride. If they do not have a helmet, there will be ones provided. Students cannot have allergies to horses!!

String Art – $(5^{th} - 8^{th}) - 2$ -day class

Elective Classes –

These classes may be offered on multiple days but you only need to sign up for a SINGLE section of the class.

Animal Jewelry Picture – (5th-8th)

Use old jewelry, buttons, ribbon, or feathers to create a fun picture. Maybe a Paw print, or a seahorse, or perhaps a rooster!



Basketball Skills – (all) Practice basic basketball skills and play some games



Beaded Keychains - (5th-8th)

Using string and multi-colored pony beads, campers will craft various Bead Animals.



Beaded Sun Catcher – (all) Make a beautiful beaded suncatcher that will glisten in your window.





Boho Hoop Plant Holder – (all) New Class! Make your own darling plant holder.



Bottle Art - (all) Use Mod Podge to decorate and bedazzle a tall bottle.





Bottle Necklaces - (all) Craft a necklace using a small glass bottle, charms, beads, and chains.



Box Diorama – Aquarium (all)

Use colored paper, stickers and various other supplies to make a shoebox aquarium diorama.



Build a Bird Feeder (all) Build and decorate your very own bird feeder.



Caramel Apples - (5th-8th)

Make some yummy caramel apples for a treat to take home.

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Carnival Games – (all)

Fingernail Art for Girls (Manicure)– (all) Campers will learn to decorate their nails in fancy designs.



Fun with Frisbee – (all)


Live Edge Coat Hook– (<mark>5th-8th</mark>)
