The list begins with the **Core Classes**.

These classes meet more than one day or meet for two hours on a single day. Camper is required to be there all the days or hours.

The list following the Core Classes are **Elective Classes**.

They are one day classes.

CORE CLASSES – Classes are TWO days long or meet for TWO hours on a single day

Archery – 5th – 8th graders



Experts from Grand Valley Sporting Goods will be here to teach the basics of Archery.

Ballet Basics – all ages

First Aid Plus - 5th – 8th graders

Pony Class – 2nd – 5th graders



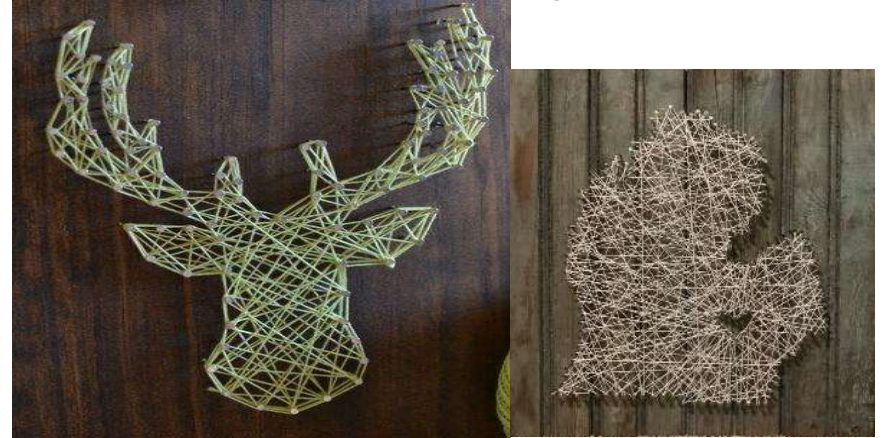

Cookie Decorating - 5th – 8th graders



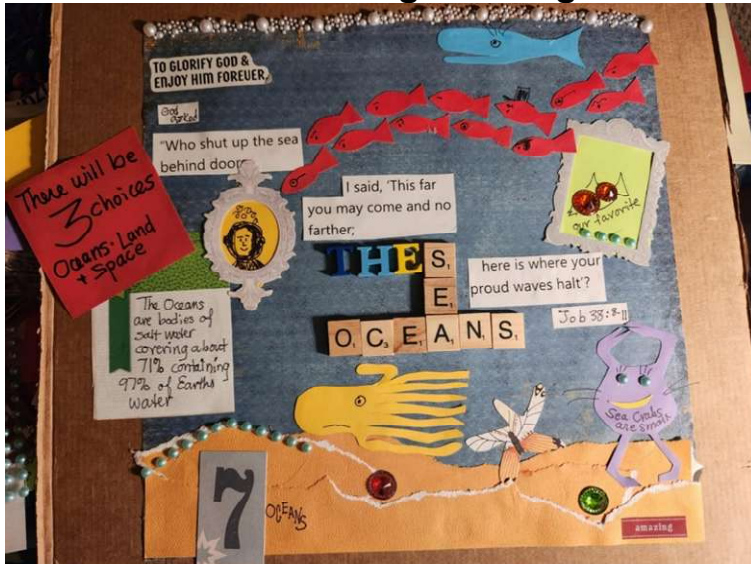
New this year, learn the techniques of decorating cookies with royal icing!

Cookies in the Kitchen – all ages



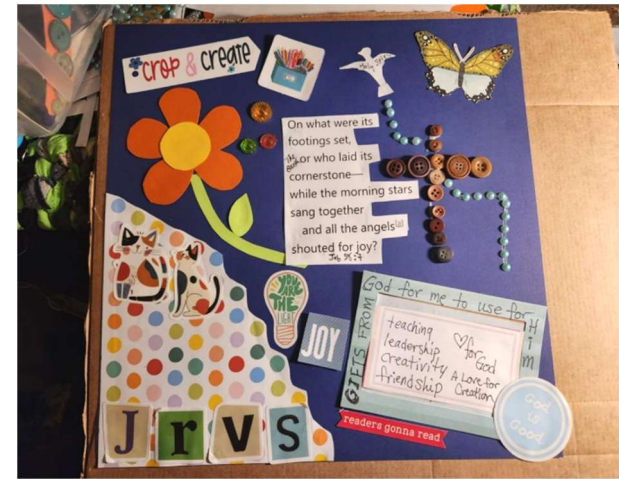
An all-time favorite class – work in a group to make a delicious batch of chocolate chip cookies ... that you get to sample!

Metal Robots- 5th – 8th graders



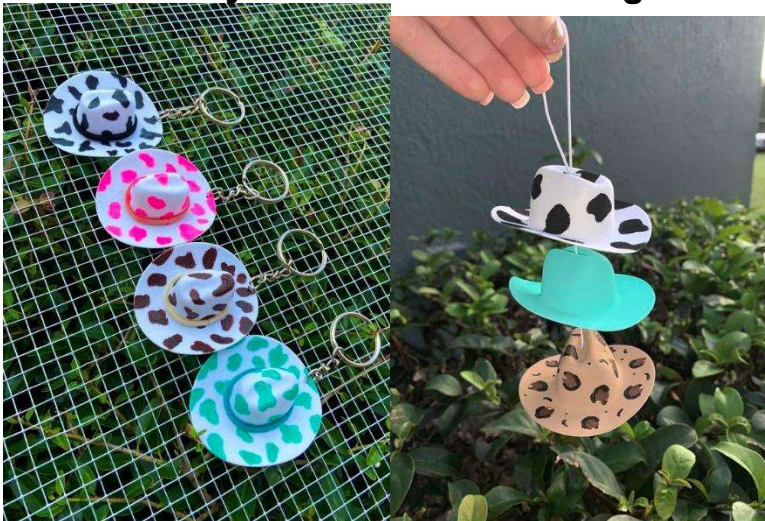
Use cans, and odds and ends to create your own robots.

Stepping Stones – all ages



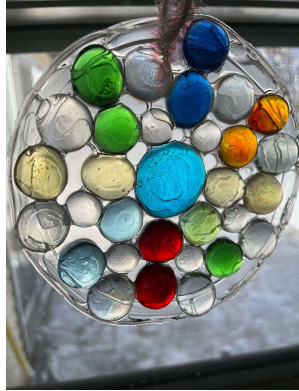
